ADVANCED BRAKING CONTROL SYSTEMS (1 Day*)

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course focusses on conducting advanced diagnostic testing on typical ESP systems components and identifying component faults that require replacement or repair. It will also enable delegates to conduct complete diagnostic tests on active vehicle systems to locate faults.

TYRE PRESSURE MONITORING SYSTEMS (TPMS) (1/2 Day*)

COURSE OVERVIEW

As part of a leading manufacturer in TPMS systems this course is aimed at providing the delegate will skills to manage the function and operation of both direct and indirect Tyre Pressure Monitoring Systems. They will also be able to diagnosis system faults using fault code access and special functions tests as an integral part of the learning experience.

INTRODUCTION TO VEHICLE ELECTRICAL SYSTEMS (1 Day)
